



Cook Set Instructions (for small and large pots)

Thank you for purchasing SOTO's Hard Anodized Aluminum Cook set. For your safety and to prolong the use of this cook set, please read these instructions before using.

Cautions

1. Use soft sponge and dish washing detergent to thoroughly clean the surface of the cook set.
2. Wash and dry cook set one day before stowing so that it can thoroughly dry.
3. To avoid scratching the surface, never use a wire brush or coarse materials to clean the cook set.
4. Never fill the cook set to the rim with water or other foods. Use caution and adjust the flame to avoid boiling over when cooking.
5. Be careful with the handles as they become hot due to heat from the flame. Failure to do so may result in burning.
6. The flame from the gas burner may burn pot handles. The resin cover may melt if it comes into direct contact with the flame.
7. Never store food in the cook set for a long period of time.
8. Do not place empty cook set directly on flame as this may result in damage to the cook set.
9. Avoid applying any strong impact to the cook set.
10. Avoid placing any strong acid or alkaline materials in the cook set.
11. Never use this cook set with a kerosene stove, stovetop or fire from firewood.
12. This cook set is not designed for use with a microwave or indoors oven.
13. Keep this product out of the reach of children.
